



Update Guide

(How to update/upgrade to the latest version of BrewTrax)

Even if you are an experienced PC user, please follow the instructions step by step to avoid losing your existing data. You may wish to print these instructions first.

- **IMPORTANT** - Read the [Revision History](#) notes. As well as learning about the new features in the updated version, there will be information on fixes to the software.
- Click [HERE](#) to download the latest version of BrewTrax. Save it to your desktop, or another location on your computer.
- Take a backup of your data by clicking the icon in the top left of BrewTrax. Select **Backup / Restore | Create Backup**.
- Make a note of your systems settings. You may need to re-enter these in the new version.
- Close BrewTrax.
- Ensure you have a note of your serial number and activation key. These would have been e-mailed to you at time of purchase. If you purchased your product on CD/DVD, the details will be on the inside cover. The upgrade process may not require these when you upgrade, but if your system details have changed, you may be prompted for them.
- Go to Windows **Control Panel** and then to **Add/Remove Programs** (if using Windows XP) or **Programs and Features** (if you are using Microsoft Vista or Windows 7). Find BrewTrax in the list, highlight it and click Uninstall.
- Wait for confirmation that it has uninstalled successfully.
- Go to the location that you downloaded the new version of BrewTrax to and run "setup.exe".
- Follow the prompts and installation should complete.
- You should now be able to open the new version of BrewTrax and your existing data should be intact. You may need to re-enter your activation details.
- Proceed to the "Settings" tab and check/re-enter your preferred settings/preferences.
